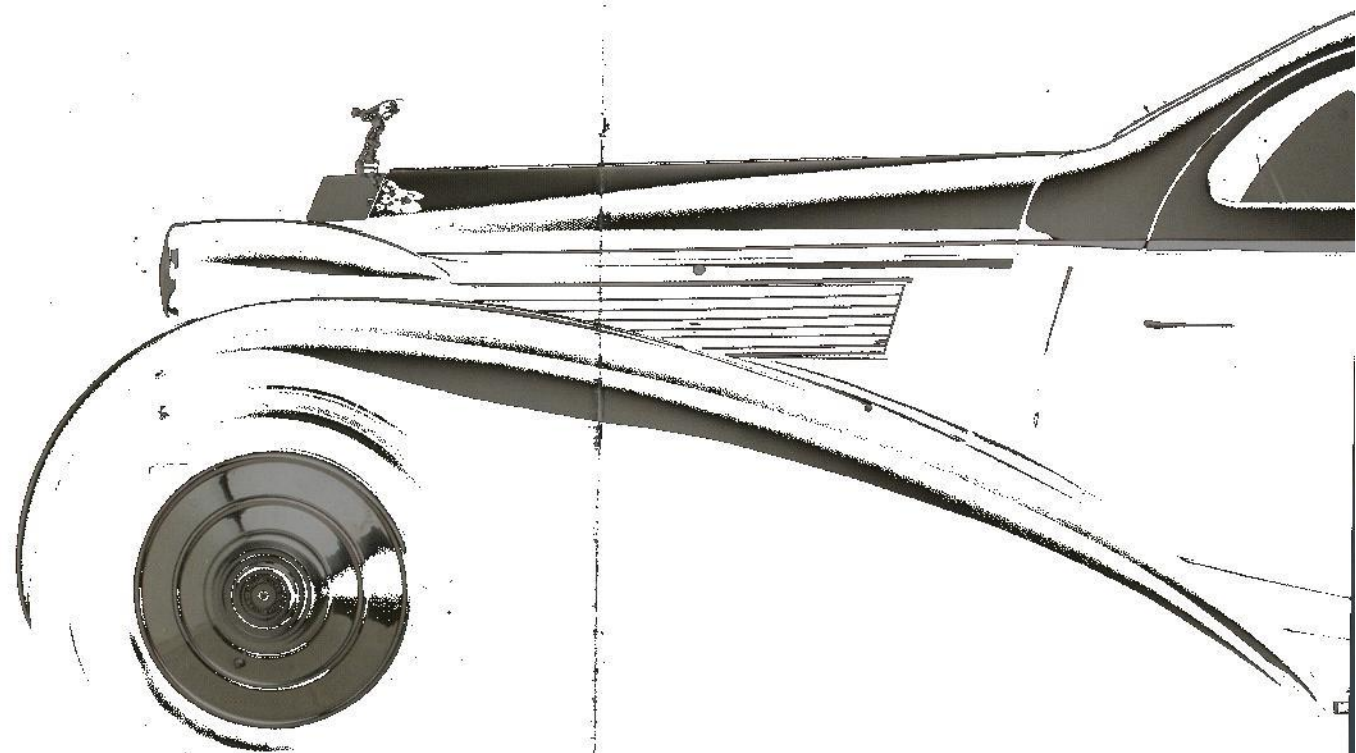

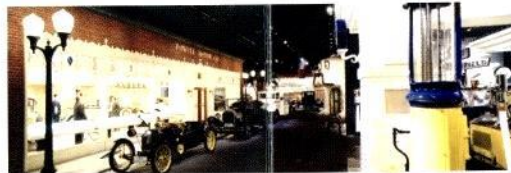

"The Streetscape" chronicles the evolution of the automobile and car culture in the 20th century. Explore how the automobile helped to shape modern Los Angeles.

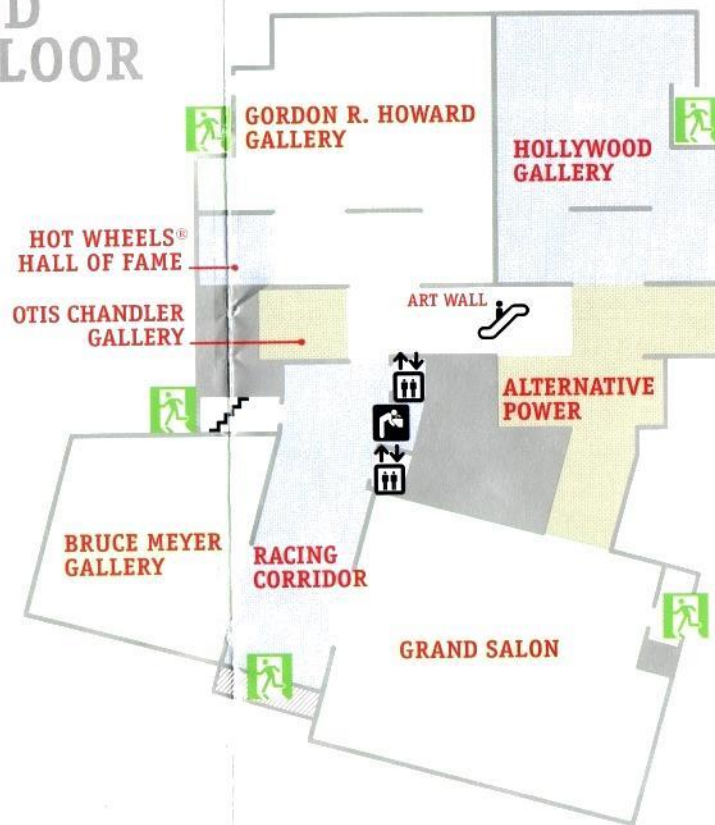

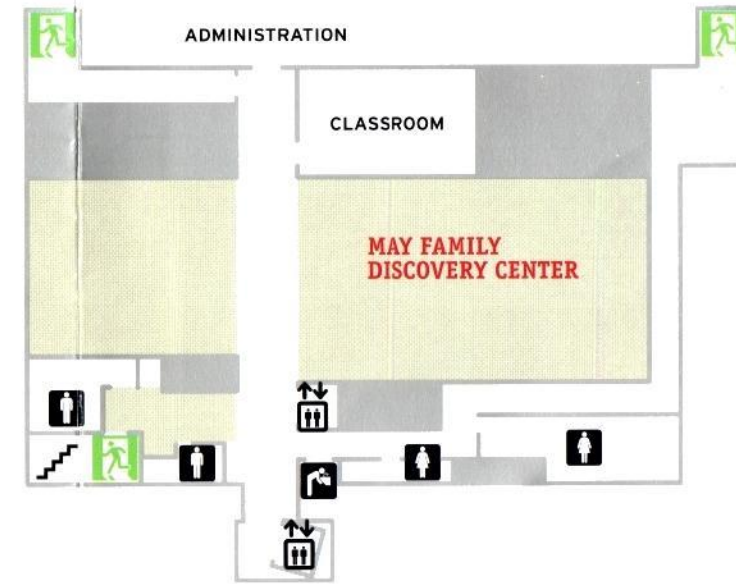
